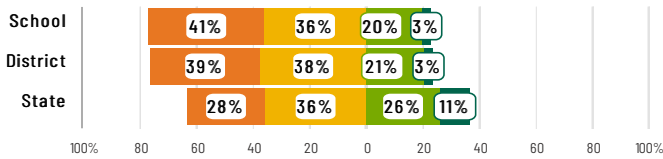

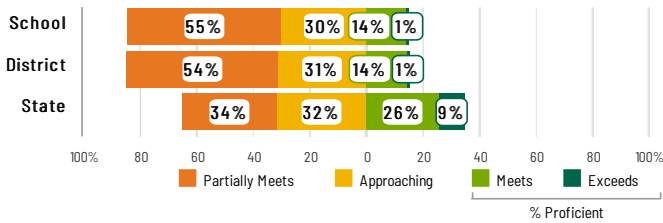

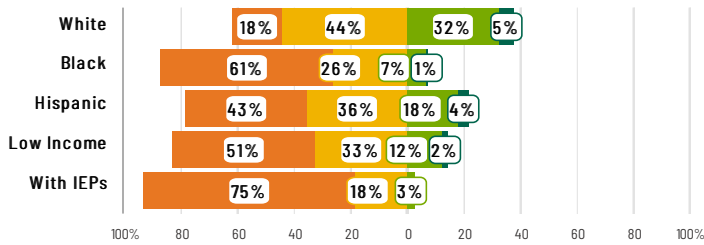

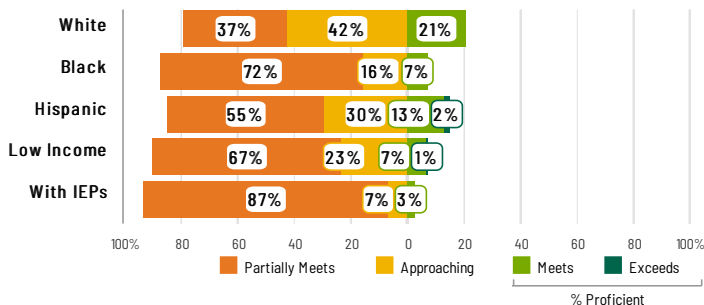
## Success by Student Group

This display shows SAT ELA & Math performance levels for each student group. No data is shown for groups with fewer than 10 students.

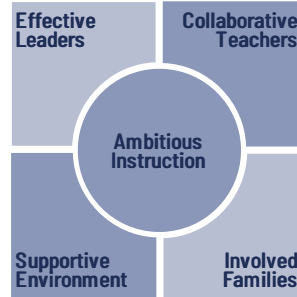

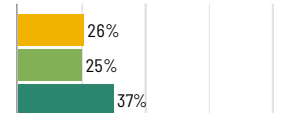

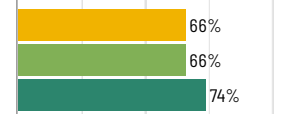

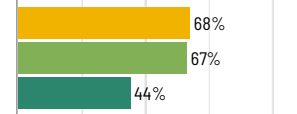

## School-Level Finance

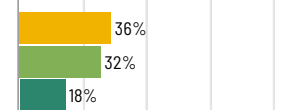
### Attendance Rate
